4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate

The qualification Aircraft Technician (instruments, radio and electrical equipment) it is possible to perform operations in the exploitation and wider maintenance (renewal/overhaul) of the aircraft. The specific aim, tasks and content of the aircraft technician (instruments and radio electronics) training program are set out in the regulations and recommendations of the International Civil Aviation Organization. Maintenance work is carried out on electrical equipment, radio-navigation equipment, radar equipment and aircraft instruments. Maintenance works include pre-, interand post-flying inspection, periodic examinations, examinations for the purpose of extending and acquiring airworthiness, examinations of reconstruction and repairs on aircraft and minor modifications. Employment is possible in aircraft-technical centres and in a growing number of new airports from which charter flights run and every charter company has its own team of people working on aircraft maintenance.
