Can be employed in various types and categories of catering facilities, such as restaurants, kitchens of catering facilities and kitchens within hospitals, kindergartens, schools, canteens and other commercial and non-commercial catering facilities. A cook has the opportunity to advance in the profession, to the positions of chef, restaurant manager and head of the food and drinks department. Self-employment is possible by setting up a catering trade.
